

COVID STATUS at HEDONISM II

Dermot De Loughry, the new General Manager at Hedonism II, helps to dispel some rumors and misinformation about the resort with respect to Covid-19 cases.

What additional safety protocols have you added to help protect the guests at Hedo? All guests from all countries need a negative test result before staying at Hedonism. Previously only Americans had to be tested prior to arrival.

Is the Ministry of Health planning to shut down the resort? No there are no plans to shut down Hedo. The Ministry makes regular visits to the resorts to make sure all protocols are followed. So far, they have had nothing but praise for Hedo’s efforts to follow all the protocols.

Since you have implemented the extra protocol of providing a Negative Covid-19 Test upon arrival at the resort, have you had any active cases on site? There are no active cases at the resort. The last guest who was diagnosed left on November 12th after being quarantined for the required time.

If people follow the safety protocols of the resort, can they get Covid-19 from staying at Hedo? Even with rigorous protocols there is always a possibility, but it is less likely than being out and about, visiting a gas station or a store or coming in contact with someone at work or anywhere else you visit.

With respect to the staff, how often are they tested? Have any tested positive? Many of the staff have been checked already and from next week, every member of the staff will be re-checked, department by department.

One member of staff from the maintenance department was diagnosed with it some time ago. She is currently in isolation. A list of persons who she has been in contact with are being traced and tested as per the guidelines.

For those people who are debating if they should come to Hedonism at this time, what advice do you have.

Hedo respects everyone’s choice whether to travel or not. And asks everyone else to respect other people’s decisions without judgement either way.

Hedonism is taking all the precautions and doing all the right things. And of course, we all we know we can get Covid-19 anytime, anywhere, by simply leaving our home. So if you want to go to Hedo, just go and have a great time. But if you’re worried, then simply stay home and wait until next year.

And remember, if you are heading down to Hedo, please be careful at home before leaving your country and while you are travelling so you don’t unknowingly bring the virus to the resort.
